Opening Our Doors With Safety & Security



General Visitation Guidelines:

- Each resident/responsible party can have only TWO guests at a time. Two compassionate care visitors/essential caregivers are allowed (per state regulations).
- All guests must wear a mask and follow social distancing and PPE guidelines.
- Visits must be scheduled in advance and the length of visit is limited to allow for cleaning between visitors.
- Visitors must log in by name with date & time of entry
- Visitors under the age of 18 can visit if they are able to comply with PPE requirements and maintain social distancing (a distance of 6 ft with residents & staff).
- General visitation will take place in designated areas, only after a health screening and temperature check is completed, and consent is given to the Visitation & Infection control policy.
- **General visitors may visit residents in their room provided they make an appointment and wear full PPE provided by Inspired Living.**
- Outside food & beverages are not allowed in the community.



Guidelines for Visits Outside of the Community:

- Departures should be for medical appointments and residents must wear a face mask (if tolerated).
- Residents must be screened on return to the community.

Visitation shall take place ...

- In the designated area(s)
- After health screening and temperature check
- With staff monitoring, infection control and prevention, hand hygiene, social-distancing, and proper disinfecting before and after each visit.

All visitors must wear a mask both inside and outside of the community.

Guidelines for Compassionate Care Visitors and Essential Caregivers:

- These are people who provide support, including emotional support, to help residents deal with difficult transition or loss, upsetting events, end-of-life situations, significant changes (such as new admission to the community), the need for assistance, cueing or encouraging with eating or drinking, or emotional distress or decline.
- **Each resident is allowed TWO Compassionate Care Visitors/Essential Caregivers - these visitors must wear full PPE provided by Inspired Living.**
- Family members, friends, and individuals visiting residents in end-of-life situations will be permitted in consultation with the Executive Director.
- Essential caregivers must have documentation of a negative COVID-19 test within 14 days of the first visit and will be given infection control instruction, including proper use of personal protective equipment (PPE), hand hygiene, and required social distancing.



Vaccinated persons who suspect exposure to COVID-19 are not required to quarantine if they meet ALL of the following criteria:

- Two weeks have passed since their final vaccination.
- Less than 90 days have passed since their second or final vaccination and they are asymptomatic since the potential COVID-19 exposure.
- If 90 days have passed since the last COVID-19 vaccination, and exposure may have occurred, Inspired Living will conduct a Risk Assessment to determine if quarantine is warranted.

General visitation will immediately cease for 14 days if a resident tests positive for COVID-19 (or is exhibiting symptoms indicating he or she is may be COVID-19 positive), or if an associate who is in the community 10 days prior tests positive for COVID-19.



All visitors must immediately inform the community if they develop fever or symptoms consistent with COVID-19 or test positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of visit to the community.
